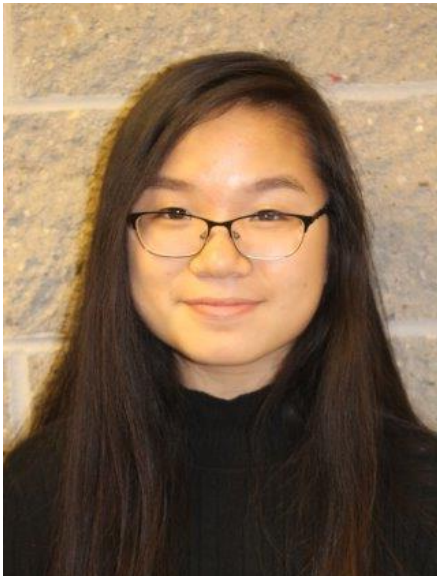

This is Catherine's fourth show with Theatre West and she is excited to continue to be part of an awesome program. Also, she would like to give a shout out to the sound fam for being da best.



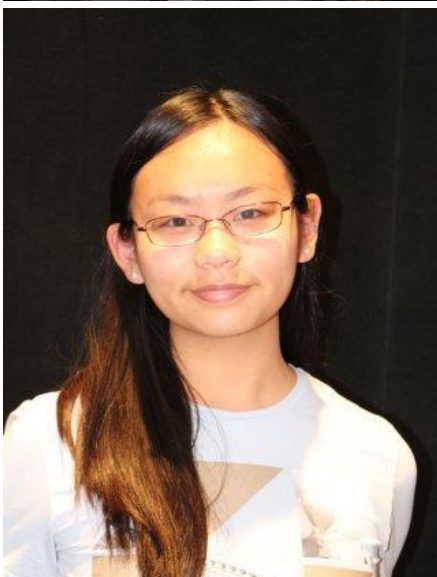

Frances enjoys helping out with theater every year and loves watching the shows. She is excited about this year's play and is eager to see how everyone's hard work will turn out.



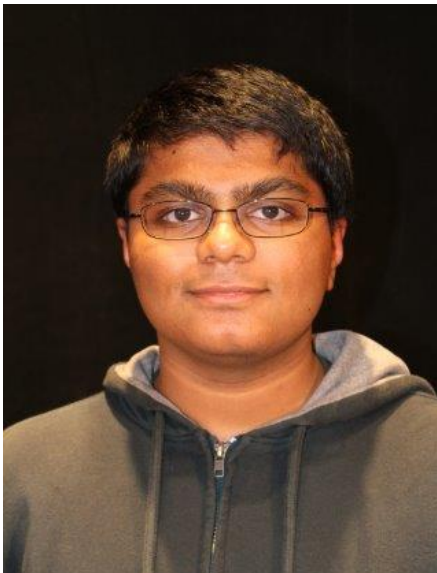
Callie Dains (head of set)
